Dear Families in Karlsruhe,

Are you looking for a childcare place for your child in a daycare facility within the city of Karlsruhe? Below, you will find the most important information about the Kita-Portal.

What is the Kita-Portal?

The Kita-Portal is a centralized information and preregistration system for childcare places in daycare facilities provided by the City of Karlsruhe. All municipal and independent providers participate in this system. The goal is to simplify the registration process for a daycare place.

Please note that the allocation of childcare places is solely managed by the facility management and providers, based on the pre-registrations made in the Kita-Portal.

Pre-registrations allow you to indicate your need for a childcare place at a daycare facility.

To create a pre-registration, you need to register first.

How does it work?



1. Register



2. Get Information



3. Create Pre-Registrations



4. Receive Placement Offer

Register

After successfully registering, you will be prompted to enter your personal information.



You can then use your login credentials to access your personal area at any time.

Get Information

Using the search function in the "Childcare Options" section, you can look for daycare facilities. Various filter options allow you to tailor your search to meet your specific needs.

Create Pre-Registrations

If you find daycare facilities that match your search criteria, you can create pre-registrations for them. We recommend creating multiple pre-registrations.

Please note: Creating a pre-registration does not guarantee a childcare place in a specific facility.

Receive Placement Offer

Once you have created a pre-registration, it becomes visible to the respective facility's management. As soon as a daycare facility can offer you a childcare place, you will be notified of the placement offer via email.

Daycare by licensed childminders



Until the age of three, your child can also be cared for in daycare by licensed childminders.

This form of care is an alternative childcare option that adheres to the same legal requirements as daycare facilities in terms of education, care, and developmental support.


